Little Azariah was born on May 5th at the University of Michigan Hospital in Ann Arbor, then was reborn two days later into the Christian family, being baptized by his grandfather, Pastor Paul Pollex. Rebecca and the children are staying with Ted's mother in Windsor, Canada, while all the necessary documents are obtained so that little Azariah can return to the Dominican with the Kreys. The ceremony began with a choir consisting of youth with disabilities singing Chilean and Colombian folklore music, followed by the scriptural reading of the pool of Bethesda whereby an angel would stir up the waters of Bethesda and heal the first who entered there. The pastors then dedicated the school in the name of the Triune God followed by a processional into the church with a Divine service also celebrating 10 years of the Lord and His gifts amongst them.
