The head of each household should see that the children learn the Bible stories beginning in the early childhood years in preparation for Catechism class with the pastor. It is best to set a time each day to instruct your household in these basic truths.*

*The Bible readings are arranged thematically based on the Catechism lesson for the week and the Church seasons over a three year period in order to give a basis for understanding the flow of the Bible. Prepared by Pastor James Wright.*

### Daily Themes for Prayer

- Sunday: For the joy of the resurrection amongst us: true and godly worship throughout the world; and the faithful preaching and hearing of God's Word.
- Monday: For faith to live in the promises of Holy Baptism; your calling and daily work, for the unemployed; the salvation and well being of our neighbors, for government; and for peace.
- Tuesday: For deliverance against temptation; the addicted and despairing; the tortured and oppressed; and those struggling with sin.
- Wednesday: For marriage and family; living together under the grace of Christ and according to the Word of God; those adults who must raise their children alone; and godly schools, especially ALIS Lutheran School, our church schools, and seminaries.
- Thursday: For the church and her pastors; for missionaries; fruitful and right use of the Lord's Supper.
- Friday: For the preaching of the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ; its spread throughout the whole world and our community; the persecuted.
